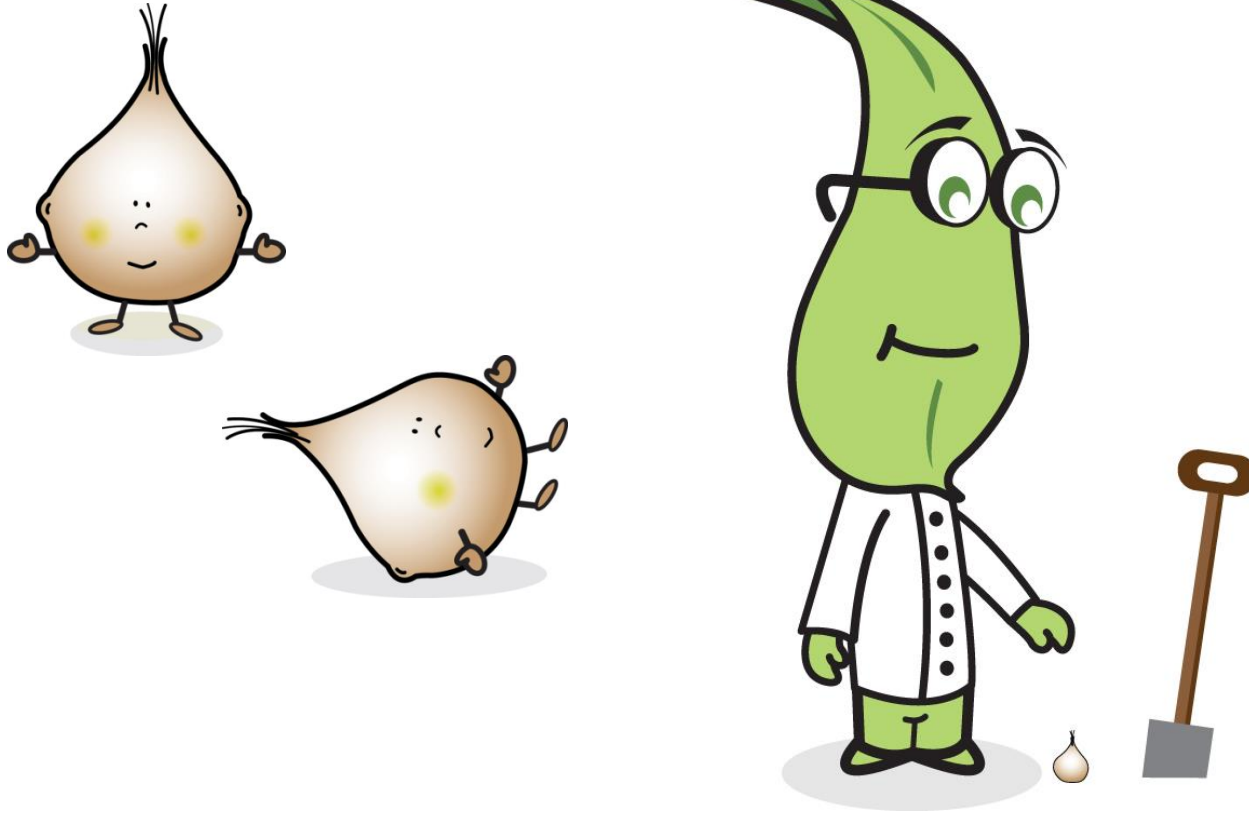
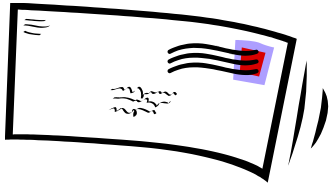
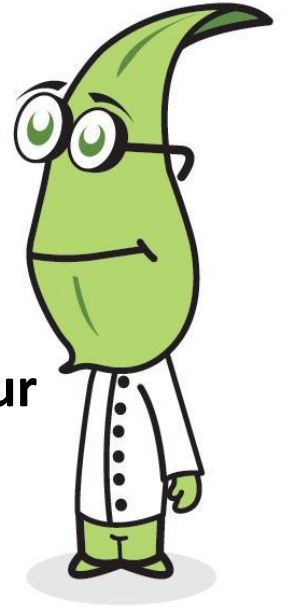


Planting your bulbs in the ground

Congratulations on passing the last task and adopting your new bulbs and bulb plot!

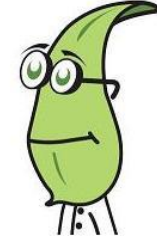
Now you are ready for the next task –

Remember to always care for your bulbs and plot as you have promised in your adoption certificate.

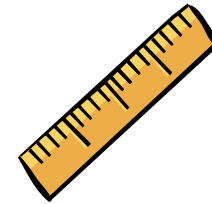


Get your equipment ready!



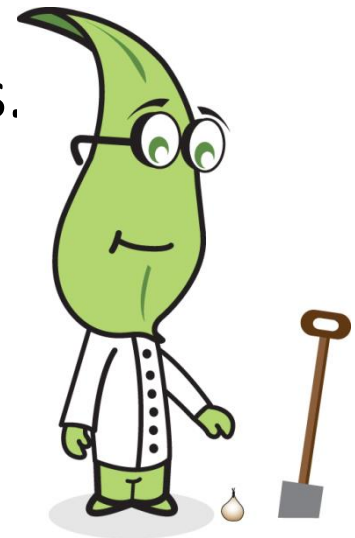
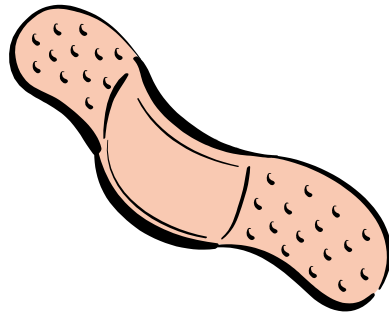
To plant your bulbs in the ground you will need:

- 20 Daffodil bulbs
- Ruler
- Trowel
- 20 Plant labels – labelled 1 to 20 with permanent marker
- Your Edina Trust Bulb Plot sign!



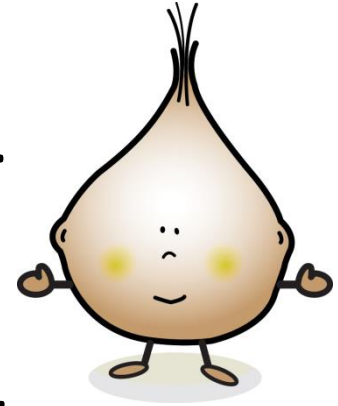
Health & Safety!

Remember your bulbs are alive - hold them gently!

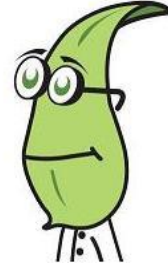
Take your time to plant your bulbs properly.

fair test.

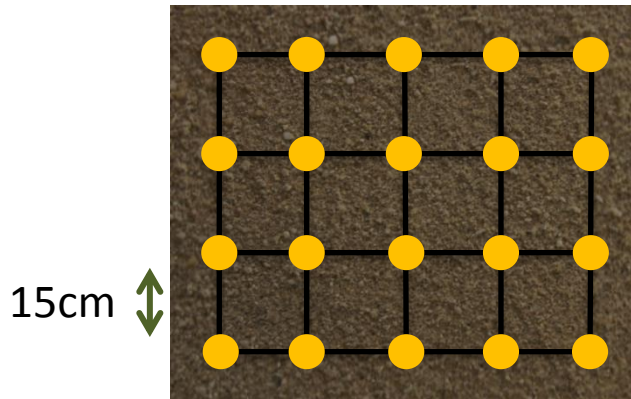

How to plant

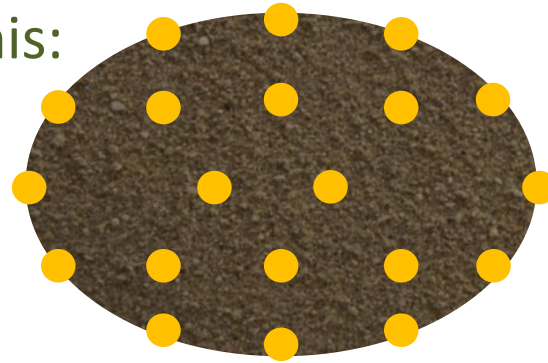


- 1) Bulbs should be planted 15cm apart so first work out how you are going to arrange the bulbs in your plot

You could plant them like this:



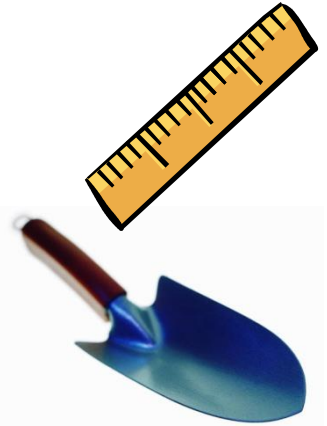
Or this:



It's up to you!

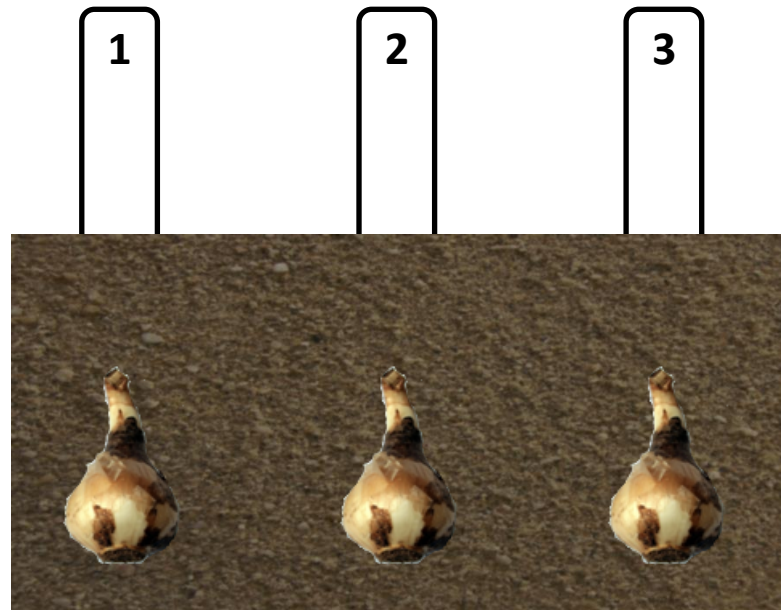
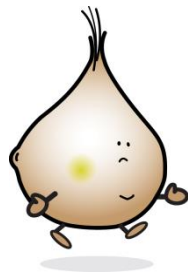

- 2) Once you have decided how you want to arrange your bulbs, mark out your bulb plot using a ruler and trowel to make a small hole where each of the bulbs are to be planted.
- 3) Using the trowel then dig a narrow hole 20cm deep where marked for each bulb
- 4) Place a bulb at the bottom of the hole, making sure it has its pointy end facing upwards and it's roots facing down

- 5) Sprinkle soil over the bulb until it is covered then press it down gently with your fingers
- 6) Fill up the hole to the top
- 7) Place a numbered label in the soil so you can remember where each bulb is planted
- 8) Repeat this for each bulb
- 9) Water well, then top-up the holes with more soil if necessary

10) Finally, it's time to put up your Edina Trust Bulb Project sign!
