## Science Grant Scheme - Year 2

The Edina Trust Science Grant scheme is now in its second year in Dundee City. The scheme is currently open to 45 schools and nurseries in Dundee City and in the 2013/14 school year Edina received and approved 38 grant applications.

The scheme entitles each eligible primary or nursery school to apply for a £550 science grant every school year for up to **three years**.

We want to make sure that no school misses out on the chance to help us get exciting, investigative science into primary schools. The scheme is running for a further two years so make sure you get your application in!

**Whatever you want to do to increase pupils' enjoyment of science, you can apply for up to £550 to help you do it!**

It might be useful to plan how you will spend the next two years worth of grants before applying so you have a clear idea of where the money will go and how it will benefit your science lessons. Spending the grant on equipment or outdoor learning resources would ensure a lasting impact on science in your school. Schools particularly like Dark Dens, Log Boxes and K'nex. What will you spend your grant on?

### School Reports

Please don't forget that when you complete a project or a science visit that was funded by Edina Trust we ask for a report. This doesn't mean a lot of extra work as Edina like to keep things simple and appreciate any feedback given. You can send in school work or reports that have already been done during class time or you can simply fill in our short evaluation form. Reports should aim to be submitted *six months* after science equipment was purchased or *one month* after a science visit occurred. - a project description including what you hope to achieve and how you will embed the experience into the pupils' learning.

- No retrospective applications will be accepted.
