Science Grant Scheme

Happy New Year and welcome to a new term in the second year of the Edina Trust Science Grant Scheme and thank you to those schools that have already applied for a grant. The scheme began in Dundee City in October 2013 and we received 38 applications and sent out grants totalling £19,695. We are very excited by continuing schemes in Dundee City and hope that we can increase the number of grants given this year. Our hope is that every state-funded primary school, nursery, and special needs school will receive their **grant to go towards a science project** by the end of the summer term.

All you need to do is fill out our simple application form. You can apply for any of the following:

- ◆ Science equipment
- ◆ Science trips or visiting workshops (**a date is required when applying!**)
- ◆ School science weeks or projects
- ◆ Gardening clubs (**max £350**)
- ◆ Developing an outdoor science area
- ◆ Subscriptions to science services (i.e. Primary Upd8)

The grant is intended to go towards a hands-on experience for pupils. Unfortunately we cannot accept applications for expensive electronic devices such as iPads, 'furniture' type items such as seating or expensive storage, or CPD training for teachers/teachers notes and guides. If you aren't sure about whether we will fund something, please ask before submitting an application!

The grant does *not* cover VAT of items, as schools are able to claim this back or are exempt from paying it. Please list all prices on application forms *excluding* VAT!
