Happy New Year and welcome to a new term in the first year of the Edina Trust Science Grant Scheme in Hartlepool. The Trust has been running the scheme across the UK since 2006 and we have now moved to offer the grant to schools in the North East. We are very happy to offer grants in the North East of England as the Trust is already involved with the funding of some projects created and delivered by LifeLab. Our hope is that every state-funded primary school, nursery, and special needs school will receive their first grant to go towards a science project by the end of the summer term.

- ◆ £500 per year for all primary schools and special schools
- ◆ £250 per year for all infant schools and junior schools
- ◆ One £350 grant to all nurseries, including state-funded nursery schools and nursery classes within schools.

All you need to do is fill out our simple application form. You can apply for any of the following:

- ◆ Science equipment
- ◆ Science trips or visiting workshops (**a date is required when applying!**)
- ◆ School science weeks or projects
- ◆ Gardening clubs (**max £350**)
- ◆ Developing an outdoor science area
- ◆ Subscriptions to science services (i.e. Primary Upd8)
