## Happy 2014!!

Welcome back to the first academic year of the Edina Trust Science Grant Scheme in Inverclyde, so far 6 schools have had projects funded out of 35 primary schools, stand-alone nurseries and ASN schools.

**All** local authority primary schools, special schools and stand-alone nurseries in Inverclyde are eligible to apply for a grant of £550 towards a science project for the next **three school years** (2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16)

This means your school can receive up to £1,650 worth of grants!

There's no hurry to submit your application as you have until the end of the academic year but the sooner you start planning what you want to do with your grant the sooner you can get started, especially with National Science Week just around the corner!

### You just need to remember:

Retrospective applications are **not accepted**.

All applications **must** include:

- \* Project Description
- \* Proposed Project Date (**especially for a visit or science week**)
- \* Detailed break-down of costs
