Here at the Edina Trust we hope you all had a lovely Easter break. Welcome back to the first academic year of the Edina Trust Science Grant Scheme in Inverclyde. Congratulations to the 20 schools that have had projects funded out of the 35 primary schools, stand-alone nurseries and ASN schools.

All local authority primary schools, special schools and stand-alone nurseries in Inverclyde are eligible to apply for a grant of £550 towards a science project for the next **three school years** (2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16)

This means your school can receive up to £1,650 worth of grants!

You only have until the end of the academic year to submit an application for your first year's grant and the sooner you start planning what you want to do with your grant the sooner you can get started!

You just need to remember:

Retrospective applications are **not accepted**.

All applications **must** include:

- * Project Description
- * Proposed Project Date (**especially for a visit or science week**)
- * Detailed break-down of costs
