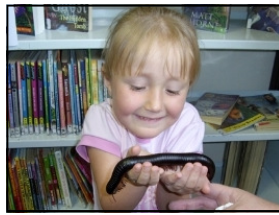

LET'S GET STARTED ON SECOND YEAR!!

Welcome back to the second school year of the Edina Trust Science Grant Scheme in Inverclyde. This is the second of three years that all primary schools, ASN schools and stand-alone nurseries in Inverclyde are eligible for a grant of **£550** towards a science project of your choice.

You have until the end of the school year to submit an application for your second year's grant and the sooner you start planning what you want to do with your grant the sooner you can get started!

Last year **77%** of all schools in Inverclyde successfully received an Edina Trust science grant, so don't miss out!! This scheme is completely **non-competitive!**

You just need to remember:

Retrospective applications are **not accepted**.

All applications **must** include:

- * Project Description
- * Proposed Project Date (**especially for a visit or science week**)
- * Detailed break-down of costs
