This is the second of three years that all primary schools, ASN schools and stand-alone nurseries in Inverclyde are eligible for a grant of **£550** towards a science project of your choice.

You have until the end of the school year to submit an application for your second year's grant and the sooner you start planning what you want to do with your grant the sooner you can get started!

### You just need to remember:

Retrospective applications are **not accepted**.

All applications **must** include:

- \* Project Description
- \* Proposed Project Date (**especially for a visit or science week**)
- \* Detailed break-down of costs (**excluding VAT**)

**Excellent reports from Super Scientists will receive a certificate!**

**Please be aware:** As a requirement of our charity regulators, the Edina Trust will be auditing 5% of all grants to improve our monitoring.

The Trust will be randomly selecting 5% of schools receiving a grant and requesting to see copies of invoices and receipts for items purchased.

The school will be notified in the approval letter that is sent to the schools with their cheque, if they have been selected.

Please make sure you read the letter and keep hold of your receipts as necessary.
