



Science Grant Scheme Update

The Edina Trust Science Grant scheme is now in its sixth year in Lancashire. There are now 250 schools eligible from this year.

The scheme entitles each eligible primary school to apply for a £550 science grant every school year for **three years**.

For those schools that have been in the project since 2012-13, **this is the last year you will be eligible to apply for a grant, so apply now – DO NOT MISS OUT!**

We want to make sure that no school misses out on the chance to help us get exciting, investigative science into primary schools.

Whatever you want to do to increase pupils' enjoyment of science, you can apply for up to £550 to help you do it!

The Edina Trust Science Grant Scheme is run in partnership with Lancashire LEA. To be eligible for the first grant one teacher per school (preferably a head of science / science coordinator) must attend a CPD course: Primary Science in the New Curriculum (for any years). Feedback about these courses has been extremely positive! After this the school can apply for the grant for three consecutive years.

SGS Policy Change

Edina Trust is now offering partial refunds on science based CPD courses run by Lancashire County Council for returning schools to the scheme.

Returning schools can pick any science related CPD course offered from Lancashire Council and then apply for a £75 refund from Edina when applying for the grant scheme.

You can choose any science related course so you can make the most out of fresh ideas for teaching and learning.

All we need to process your application is:

- a detailed cost breakdown of how you plan to spend the money
- the date of your project – especially for science visits or science weeks
- a project description including what you hope to achieve and how you will embed the experience into the pupils' learning.

Remember:

- Try to apply early before you forget, but you have until the end of the school year to submit your application,
- No retrospective applications will be accepted.
