Science Grant Scheme Update

This is now the third year that the Edina Trust science grant scheme has been open to selected primary schools in Lancashire and this year it is available to more schools than ever before.

There are now 328 schools eligible and, even more exciting news, the grant total has been increased to £550!

Last year schools did a fantastic job of applying, with 186 receiving grants of up to £500. This year we want to make sure that none of you miss out on the chance to help us get exciting, investigative science into primary schools. You can give your pupils the chance to do some real hands-on messy science and maybe stock up on some fun equipment at the same time.

Remember:

- There's no hurry to submit your application as you have until the end of the academic year but the sooner you start planning what you want to do with your grant the sooner you can get started!
- No retrospective applications can be accepted.
- Each primary school in Lancashire will be invited to apply for a science grant each year for three years (with lucky pilot schools receiving the chance of a grant for 4 years).
