



SCIENCE GRANT SCHEME IN LINCOLNSHIRE

The Edina Trust is a charity that aims to support and help improve the quality of science education for primary school and early years pupils across the UK. The Trust provides three year schemes of **non-competitive** grants to state-funded schools in selected areas.

- ♦ **ALL** Primary and ASN Schools are eligible to a grant of **£500 per year for three years!**
- ♦ **ALL** Infant and Junior schools are eligible to a grant of **£250 per year for three years!**
- ♦ **ALL** embedded and stand-alone state-funded nursery classes and schools are eligible for a **one-off grant of £350!**

Request and submit your science grant scheme application forms to **Grace** (grace.evans@edinatruster.org.uk).

You just need to remember:

Retrospective applications are **not accepted**.

All applications **must** include:

- * Project Description
- * Proposed Project Date (**especially for a visit or science week**)
- * Detailed break-down of costs
