



## Science Grant Scheme Update

This is the first year that the Edina Trust Science Grant Scheme has run in South Lanarkshire. At present there are 145 schools eligible to apply for the grant and already this academic year over 40 South Lanarkshire schools have received funding through the grant scheme.

**All** local authority primary schools, ASN schools and stand-alone nurseries in South Lanarkshire are eligible to apply for a grant of £550 towards science projects for the next **three school years** (2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15)

This means your school can receive up to £1,650 worth of grants!

There's no hurry to submit your application as you have until the end of the academic year but the sooner you start planning what you want to do with your grant the sooner you can get started!
