This is the **last year** of the Science Grant Scheme in South Lanarkshire. Which means this is the last opportunity to receive a grant of £550 to put towards science equipment, science weeks, science workshops, science subscriptions, gardening clubs or grounds for science projects!!!!

All primary schools, stand-alone nurseries and ASN schools are eligible for this last year of funding from the Edina Trust, so don't miss out!!

In the 2013/14 school year South Lanarkshire schools received over £65,000 from the Edina Trust towards science based projects. This is a **non-competitive** grant available to **all** primary schools, stand-alone nurseries and ASN schools.

You just need to remember:

Retrospective applications are **not accepted**.

All applications **must** include:

- * Project Description
- * Proposed Project Date (**especially for a visit or science week**)
- * Detailed break-down of costs
