## Science Grant Scheme

Welcome back after the Easter break! The Trust is encouraging you to apply now for a simple, non-competitive grant to aid in the teaching and learning of primary science. Our hope is that every state-funded primary school, nursery, and special needs school will receive their first grant to go towards a science project by the end of the summer term. At the moment Edina has funded 5 primary schools and 3 nurseries in Sunderland – but we want to fund more! If you haven't yet applied for a grant this school year, this is what you can get:

- ◆ £500 per year for all primary schools and special schools
- ◆ £250 per year for all infant schools and junior schools
- ◆ A one-off £350 grant to all nurseries, including state-funded nursery schools and nursery classes within schools.

All you need to do is fill out our simple application form. You can apply for any of the following:

- ◆ Science equipment
- ◆ Science visits or workshops (**a date is required when applying!**)
- ◆ School science weeks or projects
- ◆ Gardening resources (**max £350**)
- ◆ Developing an outdoor science area (e.g. ponds)
- ◆ Subscriptions to science services (e.g. Primary Upd8)
