



Science Grant Scheme: Second Year!

Your school is eligible to receive a grant from our Science Grant Scheme to go towards a science project, even if you already had one last year. The grants are non-competitive, which means so long as your application meets our criteria you are guaranteed to get the money! All we need in return is a short report on the project or the equipment purchased.

The Science Grant Scheme offers:

- ◆ £500 per year for all primary schools and special schools
- ◆ £250 per year for all infant schools and junior schools
- ◆ A one-off £350 grant to all nurseries, including state-funded nursery schools and nursery classes within schools.

All you need to do is fill out our simple application form. We will need to know:

- ◆ A description of the project – what will you use the money for? How will the pupils benefit?
- ◆ A cost breakdown – we will need you to list the price (excluding VAT) of all items that you plan to buy.
- ◆ The number of pupils that will benefit from the grant. This can be an estimate.
- ◆ A date for any visiting workshops, trips out of the school, or science weeks. This can be a provisional date and can be changed later; please just let us know!

We hope to give grants to all eligible schools this year!
