## **AMGUEDDFA CYMRU**

We recommend dividing the class into groups, and using the calendar to assign tasks. One of the groups may also be assigned to check on the 20 daffodil bulbs planted in the ground (your Edina Trust Bulb Plot). These bulbs are to be planted on Planting Day.

- Prepare your Edina Bulb Plot for planting. The minimum area is 75 x 60cm  $(2'5'' \times 2')$  and can be in a raised bed or a planter or directly in the ground.
- Plant your 20 extra daffodil bulbs in the Edina Bulb Plot. Refer to the 'Planting Your Bulbs' PowerPoint Presentation for useful hints and tips.
- Take a photo of your Edina Bulb Plot and send it in to our "Planting Day Photo Competition" to win a prize! You can email samantha.moore@edinatrust.org.uk or share your photos on Twitter using the hashtag #BulbBuddies!
- Record the planting as a video and submit it as a Bulbcast entry. You can find out more about Bulbcast on the Museum website: museum.wales/ spring-bulbs
- Between October and January check your plot every two weeks to make sure your daffodil bulbs are safely buried for the winter.
- In February make sure to check you Edina Bulb Plot weekly as daffodil shoots should start to appear.
- During February and March check your Bulb Plot daily and record a flowering date for **each** daffodil planted in the ground.
